IMPORTANT: Prior to inspecting mother trees, the inspector should prepare a file with:

- checklist of eligibility criteria;
- list of allocated trees;
- application to enter plants into the certification scheme (Appendix 3/A);
- Nursery registration certificate (Appendix 2/A).

Eligibility Criteria

- Review the checklist of eligibility criteria that should have been completed before allocation of mother plants.
- If an eligibility checklist was not completed during a previous visit by an inspector then it should be done at the time of nursery inspection and attached to this form.
- If the nursery did not adequately satisfy any eligibility criteria, then find out what actions have been taken to rectify the problems since the previous visit and/or inform the nursery owner what further actions are required. Record details:

Check the Identity of the Mother Plants

Compare the mother trees in the nursery together with their signs and labels and the following documents in order to check that all mother trees are correctly labelled and sign posted.

- List of allocated plants
- Delivery note
- Map of the mother tree block
- Application to enter plants into the certification scheme

If there are any issues, record the details:

If the map of the mother tree block is of poor quality, then the inspector and nursery owner should make a new map and attach a copy to this form. The map should show:

- The name of the nursery owner.
- GPS coordinates.
- The shape and dimensions of the mother tree block.
- Orientation (north-south-east-west).
- Key neighboring features such as a gate, building, road/track, wall, canal, entry point of irrigation water, and exit point of drainage water.
- The rows and individual marks for the position of each mother plant.
- The identity numbers of (e.g. "HE 0167") of the mother plants.
